Take Highway 92 North to Half Moon Bay

Turn Left onto **HIGHWAY 1 /CABRILLO HWY South**- go about 15 miles.

Turn Left on **PESCADERO CREEK RD** (right before yellow flashing light) go 2 miles.

Turn Right on **STAGE RD** - The Native Sons Hall is (the white, church-like structure) just pass the Post Office.
